SURFACE OF THE VINEYARD _ 81 ha

METHOD OF VITICULTURE _ Certified Organic: Ecocert
& Biodynamic: Biodyvin and Demeter

SOILS _ Quaternary Gravel

SOILS MAINTENANCE _ Shallow tillage

PRUNING _ Double Guyot - Médocain style

AVERAGE AGE OF VINES _ 50 years old

PLANTATION DENSITY _ 9500 vines per ha

GRAPE VARIETALS _ 62% Cabernet Sauvignon / 32% Merlot
4% Cabernet Franc / 2% Petit Verdot

HARVESTS _ By hand in small crates

VINIFICATION _ Manual sorting and destemming. Alcoholic Fermentation
with indigenous yeasts, maceration of 4 weeks with soft
punching-down, malolactic fermentation in vats.

AGING _ 50% in new oak barrels, 35% in concrete amphoras,
15% in one wine oak barrels - 16 to 18 months
